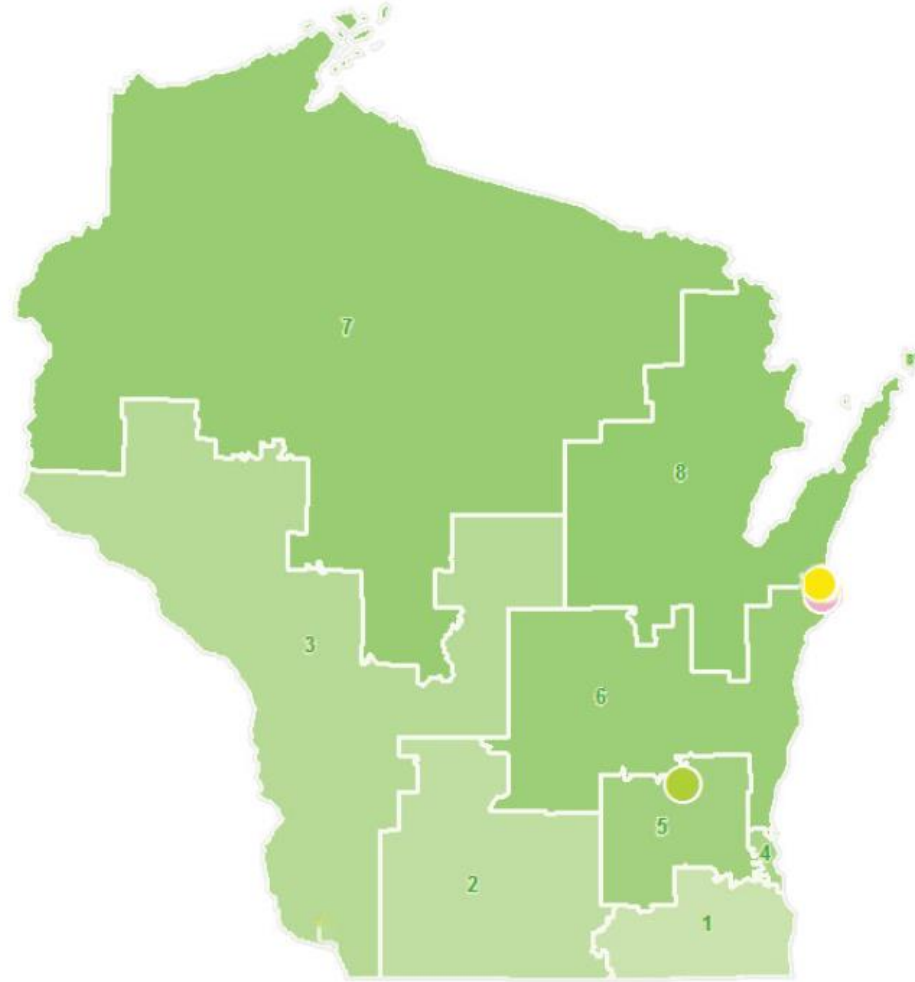

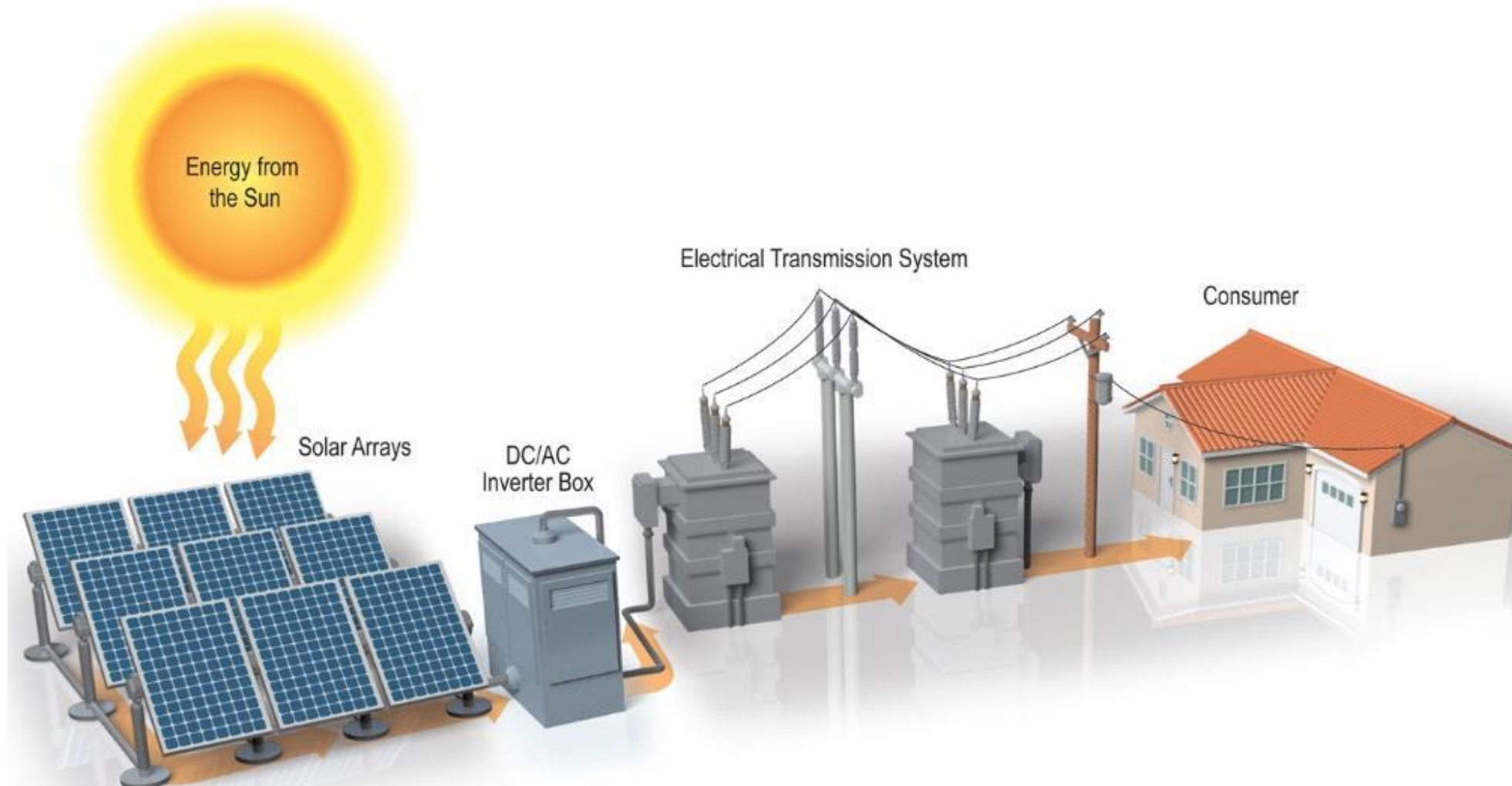
Camelot Energy Center project overview

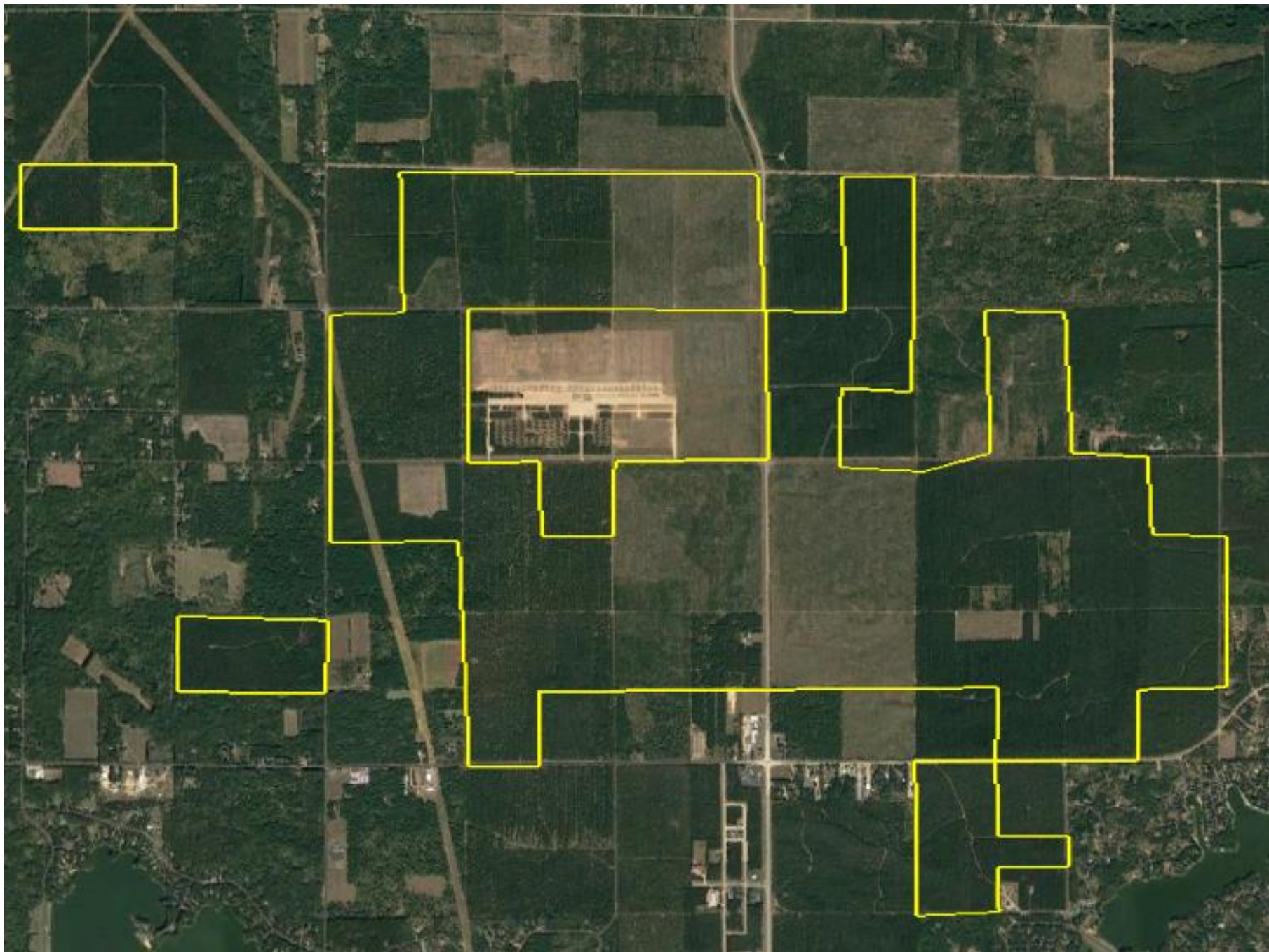
- ▶ **Located in Adams County**
- ▶ **Town of Rome**
- ▶ **~\$250 million capital investment***
- ▶ **200-megawatt project**
 - » Enough electricity to power approximately 50,000 homes
- ▶ **Connects to the 161-kilovolt American Transmission Co substation Saratoga**
- ▶ **Commercial operation targeted for January 2027**

Local community benefits

- ▶ **Shared Revenue Payments of \$800,000 every year**
 - » This is split between the county and local communities that host energy facilities.
- ▶ **Creation of approximately four new full-time, good-paying jobs**
- ▶ **Increased activity for local businesses during construction and operations**



Environmental commitment

- ▶ **NextEra Energy Resources conducts numerous studies in coordination with federal, state and/or local agencies to ensure our projects are responsibly sited, including:**
 - » Avian use and nest surveys
 - » Local species reviews
 - » Bat acoustic monitoring
 - » Habitat assessments
 - » U.S. evaluations of wetlands/waters
 - » Cultural resource evaluations
 - » Phase I environmental site assessments
